Archaeological finds indicate that the Ionian tribe settled on Mykonos in the early part of the 11th century BC. In Greek mythology Mykonos was the location of the battle between Zeus and the Titans, and the island was named in honour of Apollo's grandson Mykonos.

Today, Mykonos is one of the most cosmopolitan islands in Greece, having become increasingly popular with mass tourism. It is known for its diverse and intense nightlife featured by a vast number of bars and nightclubs. The nightlife of Mykonos is marketed as among the best in Europe, as it also attracts famous DJs to its renowned clubs and beach bars.

The visitor enjoys the island's Mediterranean climate and sunshine, as well as the Aegean winds that make the island one of the best locations for windsurf. Mykonos is also known for its sandy beaches. Some of the most famous beaches are Super Paradise, Psarou, Paranga, Kalo Leivadi, Panormos and others.
